2018 REPORT

2018 has been met with excitement and anticipation by collectors around the world. The visible health and ripeness of the berries at harvest has, as expected resulted in wines of an exceptionally high standard. The power and intensity in the reds point to a vintage of tension and expectation, one for longer ageing than the fragrant examples from 16 or the open, elegant wines of 17.

The whites are ripe and rich, careful management has preserved the precarious nature of the acid and the best are bold and bountiful, enveloping the oak expressions and promising more exuberant expression over the coming years.

HARVEST REPORT

2018 wasn't a straight forward vintage. It started in a dreary fashion, with a mild and rainy January leading into a drier, but much colder February. This deep chill allowed the vines time to hibernate before the sap rose in the spring. Rain returned in March, with significant cooling in the middle of the month, delaying bud break by one week, thus reducing frost risk, a relief for vigneron following the dramatic frost driven yield reductions of 16 and 17.

April bounced in with high temperatures and a flourish of growth, adjusting the cycle and bringing flowering forward, 6 to 10 days ahead of the average. These fluctuations in temperature continued, with heavy rain and mild temperatures doing their best to disrupt vine health at the end of May.

This period of unsettled weather ran its course and normal summer sunshine resumed in June. An episode of hail in July hit some parts of Nuits-St-Georges reducing effected areas by up to 50%, but these were isolated and affected just a small percentage of vineyards in the Côtes de Nuits.

September grew grey and cooled effectively, bringing an autumnal hum to the vineyards, the perfect conditions for flavours to ripen and skins to thicken. Grapes came in healthy and ripe, heightening the expectations of the excited vigneron.

2018 was a vintage unlike others before, the temperature dips and periods of rain, symptoms of climate change converged to produce a harvest that shows great balance and elegance, held together by a brooding power that has great potential for ageing and longevity in the bottle.

BOUCHARD PÈRE & FILS
FONDÉE EN 1731

As the largest vineyard owners in Burgundy, with 130 hectares of vines (including 12ha Grand Cru and 75 ha of Premier Cru), Bouchard Père et Fils are in a strong position to maximise the quality of their wines. In the vineyards the translation of terroir into glass is driven by a focus on biodiversity and soil health. Bouchard Père et Fils have practised the highest level of sustainability for the last 15 years, with the top level 3 achieved in 'High Environmental Value' (HVE) certification. The expertise of their cellar master Frederic Weber is increasingly evident in the wines, their expressions seem to gain greater complexity every year.

2018 was a warm vintage, breeding powerful, concentrated styles. Careful pressing and fermentation in stainless steel served to preserve acid levels for the whites. For the reds 2018 is described by cellar master Frederic Weber as similar in style to the excellent 2005 and 2009. The reds of 2018 combine floral perfume with energetic and complex expressions. They are certainly worthy of investment, their integrated tannins and contained power promise many years of enjoyment.

GRANDS VINS DE CHABLIS

With their focus remaining faithful to the purity of terroir, work in the vineyards remains at the forefront of workings at William Fèvre. Two-thirds of the domaine’s vineyard have been organic since 2006, with biodynamic practices in use since 2010.

The company have held the ‘High Environmental Value’ certification since 2015, promoting biodiversity and soil health amongst the vines. Cellar Master Didier Seguin describes the 2018 vintage as a ‘wonderfully mature vintage blending richness and fruitiness’. Free from frost and hail with a hot dry summer led to a harvest of grapes that were literally blooming with healthy and vivacity. Open and generous this is a vintage for those not able to wait!

In Chablis, the mild February saw spring like temperatures, tempting the buds to arrive on 25th March. Nervous about frosts, Guillaume put Bougies into the vineyards in April to protect against any cold nights. Luckily there were no nights below zero post bud-break in 2018. Flowering was successful on 25th May, followed by plenty of sunshine in July, August and September.

As Guillaume put it; two incidences of hail in the Butteaux vineyards were a ‘sharp reminder of the vagaries of the weather’. Extended dry periods and a hot August led to some signs of scorching, but this was managed carefully and harvest started on 5th September yielding a welcome vintage of high quality and high volume.

This estate dates back to the 1800's, it was Alexis Seguin who was one of the pioneers of grafting American rootstocks following the Phylloxera crisis of the 1880's. Gerard now manages the estate with his son Jerome, they have gradually been adding new parcels of vines over the years and have built up an estate of 6.25 hectares primarily in Gevrey-Chambertin. Despite being a domaine steeped in tradition, the cuverie and cellars were renovated and updated as recently as 2014.

The vineyards are run sustainably with most of the cellar work, especially the bottling, performed in conjunction with the Biodynamic calendar. Their range includes a Fixin, which is a lesser known but interesting appellation just north of Gevrey offering good value and early appeal. The Gevrey-Chambertin vineyard; "La Justice" is seen as one of the better sites of Gevrey with a lack of stones giving warmer soils and fuller wines from vines that are over 40 years old.

DOMAINE MICHEL MAGNIEN

MOREY-SAINT-DENIS



Certified biodynamic in 2015 Domaine Michel Magnien (18ha) is run by forward thinking 5th generation winemaker Frédéric Magnien. Since 2005 the estate has been certified biodynamic. This conversion has released a greater expression of terroir in the wines. In 2015 Frédéric ceased using new French oak barrels, replacing them with 160 litre terracotta amphora. In our tasting we vertically tasted barrel versus amphora, it was obvious to see that the amphora brings a freshness and life to the wines that the oak cannot provide. All of the wines we have brought in are aged in amphora.

The style of Frédéric's wines seeks freshness and fragrance. Many of his vineyards are at higher altitudes, naturally producing cooler climate expressions. Monts Luisants is planted at 350m, high for the rolling hills of Burgundy. 2018 has not yet been released. In recognition of a world where wines are released and drunk too young Frederic releases wines when he feels they are open enough to express their terroir in the glass.

Tolleot-Beaut is a most reliable source for a range of delicious consumer friendly wines that seem to get better as the years go by. The wines are beautifully open in style, with rich generous fruit flavours and judicious use of new oak. They have a certain poise, with great depth and elegance and consistently over-deliver for the price. The property was one of the very first to domaine bottle their wines in the early 1920's; today it is run by Nathalie Tolleot and her extended family.

Celebrating normal yields and healthy fruit. Nathalie shows welcome relief in her responses on the 2018 vintage. A powerful tannic structure that is ripe yet hugely age-worthy, shows long-term promise not seen since 2010. Drink your 17's now and hope stocks last till the 18's emerge pristine and succulent from their deep sleep.

DOMAINE MICHEL BOUZEREAU ET FILS

MEURSAULT



Jean Baptiste Bouzereau took over the running of the family domaine from his father Michel eleven years ago. Their philosophy is simple with vines cultivated without any chemical fertilizers and all the harvesting done by hand. The estate comprises 12 hectares predominantly in Meursault and Puligny Montrachet. The style focusses on purity, with great elegance. Concentration and finesse show great potential for aging. We include the Bourgogne Chardonnay in recognition of its depth and richness at this level; coming from vines in Meursault and Puligny this wine's quality equals many village examples from here.

2018 was a warm and plentiful vintage in Meursault, yielding wines with intensity and presence. Ones that have intensity from the start. Jean Baptiste has managed to retain the acid in his line, tightening the structure and suggesting that this wines will keep on giving, evolving and enriching.

There is no doubt that this is the finest estate in Saint Aubin where Olivier Lamy who took over from his father in 1996 and is making exquisite wines each year. Here is one of the best of examples in Burgundy of the next generation of a family lifting their estate to new heights of excellence. Olivier does a lot of experimenting in the vineyards with different planting densities in a quest to gain greater expression of terroir. In the cellar he is able to utilise three levels thus working with gravity which is better for the wines.

The increasing age of Oliver’s vines, combined with his careful management in the vineyards means that despite greater levels of ripeness in 2018 his whites have retained their acid bite and mineral depth that the domaine has become famous for. There is a quiet generosity to the wines, both white and red that suggests butterfly evolution over the coming months and years.

DOMAINE JACQUES CARILLON

PULIGNY -MONTRACHET



The Carillon family have been one of the pinnacles of winemaking in Puligny-Montrachet for generations dating back to 1692. In 2012 the Domaine was divided into two, between Jacques and his brother François. They both now have 5.5 ha each. The village Puligny and 1er Cru Les Perrières was split in half; Jacques kept 1er Crus Champs-Canet, the Referts and the entire holding of Bienvenues-Bâtard-Montrachet, also now making use of his

Chassagne-Montrachet village and Chassagne 1er Cru Les Macherelles. As chief winemaker at Louis Carillon before producing wines under his own name, followers of that domaine can be assured that his style has not changed. Despite a warm and dry summer, Jacques has held onto a glimpse of the mineral austerity that restrains the natural opulence of his wines here. As has been noted by tasters everywhere, only the best domaines have managed to contain their acid streaks giving valuable backbone to the whites. This is certainly true of the Carillon wines in 2018.

Nicolas Ragot has run his family Domaine of 9.5ha since 2008. The Domaine underwent a complete renovation in 2003 when Nicolas and his father Jean Paul upgraded the cellar. Nicolas is part of the new generation of forward thinking vignerons, trying to preserve their Domaine for the next generation. His vision for the future is one of sustainability. Work in the vineyards avoids the use of herbicides, beneficial crops act as a natural barrier against weeds and effective tool in water regulation to the vines. This approach is not limited to the vineyards; 100% of the cellar is electric, powered by solar panels.

The wines have a purity and precision. The expression of terroir lends a deep character to the wines. The ripeness and concentration of the 2018 vintage combined with Nicholas' sympathetic tannin management and increasingly mature vines, adds weight to our opinion that these wines offer some of the best value in Burgundy.
