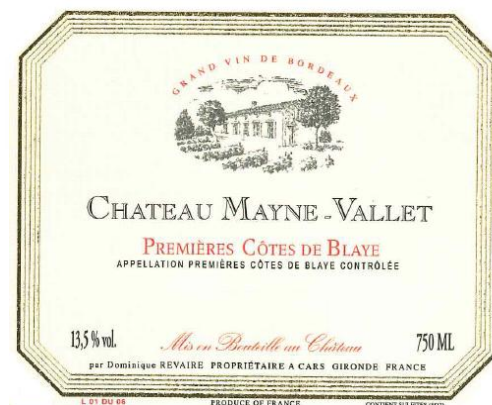

Vinification:

Mechanical harvest. Fermentation and aging in stainless steel tanks.

Traditional vinification, 2 to 3 weeks of vatting.

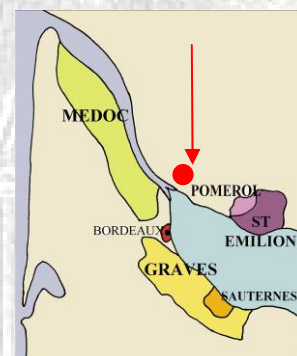
Tasting notes:

The clay and siliceous soil combined with the predominance of merlot grape gives wines which are full-bodied, soft, with a remarkable quality for aging.

History:

The Chateau Mayne Vallet has been in the Revaire Family since 1892. At the beginning, the vineyard had 6 hectares (15 acres). Over the years, the current owner increased the property with new vineyard purchases: 6 hectares (15 acres) in 1985, 1 hectare (2.5 acres) in 1988 and 3 hectares (8 acres) in 2005.
