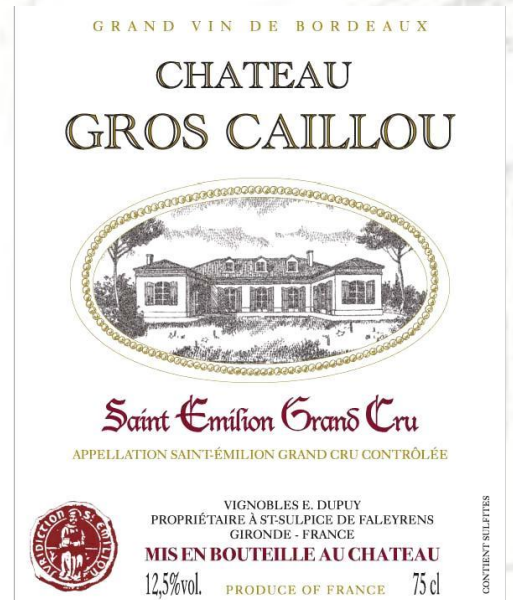
Soil: Gravel, Sand and Clay

## Vinification:

Maceration of 8 to 10 days after the warming of the must. 2/3 of the harvest is aged in stainless-steel tanks and 1/3 in barrels.

## Tasting notes:

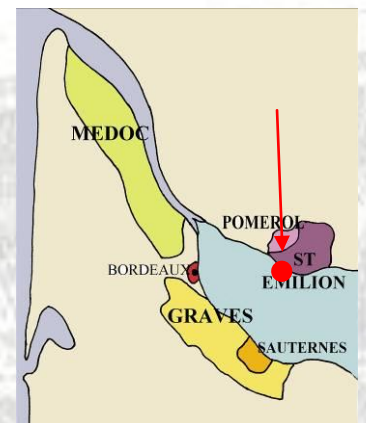
Dark color with aroma of red fruits. Good strength on entry with good concentration, aromas of forest fruits, medium-spicy tones in the mouth. An elegant wine with good maturity and a distinctive finish.

## History:

For more than four generations this estate situated in Saint Sulpice de Faleyrens – near Saint Emilion – has been the property of the Dupuy Family. It has always been known for its terroir, tradition and quality.

In 1981, Jacques Dupuy began to manage this estate of 11 hectares (27 acres). Since 1984, thanks to Jacques Dupuy, the vineyard increased significantly, and now spreads over 20 hectares (50 acres). Today, with his son Eric, they manage Château Gros Caillou and have significantly improved the winery through their passion and efforts.
