Catalan Eagle takes its name from the bird that soars above the nature reserve close to the winery.

Pepe Fuster makes wine from his 26 hectare vineyard in Terra Alta which is near Tarragona in Southern Catalonia. The vineyard is fully organically certified and the Catalan Eagle red wine will be organically certified from the 2012 vintage onwards.

Deep coloured full bodied, rich, spicy red with vanilla and cinnamon notes from American oak. Older vine Garnacha and Cariñena vines contribute complexity and depth to this seriously delicious wine.
