The LAGARDE range offers some of the finest Languedoc classic wines: fresh and charming, with a packaging that expresses strength, character and simplicity.

Lagarde Red is produced in the Languedoc region between Narbonne and Béziers, South of France. This cuvee is made from traditional grape varieties from Languedoc. The vineyard is located at the "Black Mountain" foothills. The Languedoc provides perfect ripening conditions for the red wines: sun, low yield, and good healthy conditions of the grapes.

Vinification

Picked at their optimal polyphenolic ripeness, the grapes are destemmed and crushed, and then undergo a 8 to 10 days long maceration. The wine is aged in tanks, to preserve the lovely fruity style of the wine.

Winemaker comments

The colour of the wine is ruby red. The nose is pleasant with hints of red berries and spice. The palate is easy, well rounded and balanced.

This easy-drinking wine is a perfect accompaniment to red and white meat or cheese. Serve at 15C.
